Open Access Journal

IJLE operates under the Open Access model, where all articles published in the journal are freely accessible to readers worldwide. Authors retain copyright to their work, and all articles are licensed under a Creative Commons Attribution License (**CC-BY-NC and CC-BY-NC-ND**). This license allows others to share, adapt, and build upon the published work, with appropriate attribution to the original authors and restricts commercial use of publications without prior permission from publishers.

Article Processing Charges (APCs)

To sustain the Open Access model and cover the costs associated with the peer review process, typesetting, hosting, and other publishing expenses, IJLE levies Article Processing Charges (APCs) upon acceptance of a manuscript. The APC amount will be made transparently available on the journal's website and will be subject to periodic review to ensure affordability and fairness.

The Article Publishing Charge for this journal is USD 150, excluding taxes.

Article Publishing Charge waiver & discount options: We automatically apply Article Publishing Charge waivers or discounts to those articles for which all authors are based in a country eligible to under developed and developing countries. Find out more about the APC waiver and discount eligibility here. For waiver and discount request other than country eligibility author shall write editor for such waiver.

Waiver Policy:

IJLE recognizes the importance of inclusivity and seeks to provide equal opportunities for researchers worldwide. Therefore, a partial or full waiver of APCs may be granted to authors from low- and middle-income countries, based on their financial constraints and the quality and significance of their research. The decision to grant a waiver will be at the discretion of the Editorial Board, following transparent and objective criteria.



Archiving and Indexing:

IJLE ensures the long-term preservation and accessibility of its content by partnering with reputable digital archives and repositories. All published articles will be archived in a recognized repository to maintain their availability and citability. Moreover, IJLE endeavours to secure indexing in renowned databases such as Scopus, Web of Science, and other relevant databases, further enhancing the visibility and impact of the published research.

Promotion of Open Access:

IJLE actively promotes the Open Access model and encourages authors, reviewers, and readers to advocate for unrestricted access to research. The journal supports initiatives and organizations dedicated to advancing Open Access principles in academia and the scientific community.

Author Responsibilities:

Authors submitting to IJLE should ensure they have the right to publish the work and agree to the terms of the Creative Commons Attribution License (**CC-BY-NC & CC-BY-NC-ND**). They must acknowledge any funding sources and disclose any conflicts of interest related to the research. Authors should also acknowledge if the research was previously presented at a conference to avoid potential duplicate publication issues.
